Only animated films are admitted. Each workshop group is free to choose the technique they prefer (drawn animation, cut-out, stop-frame, etc.)

Each group can join the project with one film **no longer than 2 minutes** Please deliver the film as an **MP4 or higher, HD 16:9 25frames/sec**

No dialogue in the film. It must be an international nonverbal version. All music should be royalty free or preferably self-made.

The credits will be added at the end of the project

so please do not include credits in the film but send a credit list along with your film including names of the students, instructors, assistants, credits for music or sound effects licensed under Creative Commons etc.

NEW! For the credit sequence, we'd like to create an audio scape of children reading the same sentence - a call to action, that unifies the film. We'll forward this in due time. Something along the lines of "*This is our World. We are its children and these are our dreams*'.
